

Freedom of Information request

Your request for certain information using Freedom of Information Act 2000 legislation has been received in this office.

On 3 November 2017 you specifically asked for:

“1. The number of complainants with a complaint against West Midlands Police that Mr Jamieson has had meetings with since he came into office.”

By way of response I must advise that it is not possible to provide that information. The Commissioner attends many meetings throughout the day, some evenings and occasionally at weekends: it is highly likely that whilst he is out of the office he will speak to people who wish to raise complaints with him. These meetings will not be planned or recorded in his diary which means any numbers given would be inaccurate.

Your attention is drawn to the fact that, in accordance with the Police and Crime Commissioner's review procedure, you do have a right to request an internal review of this decision. Details of the procedure are attached to this letter.
