



Performance Against Police and Crime Plan 2014-15

Report of the Chief Executive

PURPOSE

1. This report provides a summary of those deliverables allocated to the Office of the Police and Crime Commissioner.

PERFORMANCE

Creating stronger partnerships

Provide grants to local authority areas to enable the delivery of crime and community safety outcomes through the work of local policing and crime boards

2. The Commissioner made a formal decision to passport out the Community Safety Fund again in 2015-16. We are now in the process of receiving the monitoring information from each of the Boards in relation to spend in 2014-15. The Commissioner has requested a stronger emphasis on outcomes from each LPCB and a full report will come to the Board for the July meeting.

Developing greater local identity across the West Midlands

Support the newly formed local police and crime boards to strengthen their identity in the local community

3. The make-up of the Boards now better reflect the make-up of the local community due to the increased membership which includes community and voluntary sector. The Office will be working closely with the Boards during the planning process on their consultation mechanisms to ensure that the priorities are informed by local people. The Heads of Community Safety are also looking at local campaigns through the Local Police and Crime Plans to become more identifiable.

Work with local policing and crime boards to deliver the outcomes contained in their local policing and crime plans

4. The Office continues to monitor spend of the Community Safety Fund which is used to deliver the outcomes in the local plans. Each local plan is linked to the Commissioner's Police and Crime Plan.

Establish the work plan for the Youth Commission, integrating its role into the work of the Commissioner

5. The work plan for the Youth Commission is being reviewed currently, however highlights have included involvement in the Knife Surrender Bins, the work of Stephen Rimmer around CSE, mental health, local consultation with young people. A full list of Youth Commissioners for each LPU is attached at Annex A. As part of the governance arrangements the Police and Crime Commissioner and the Strategic Police and Crime Board (SPCB) agreed to hold quarterly Performance Workshops with the Force. These Workshops would give members of the SPCB additional time to scrutinise the Force regarding performance including areas which are not included in the Police and Crime Plan.
