Fees and Charges 2016/17

Report of the PCC Chief Finance Officer and Director of Resources

PURPOSE

1. This report details the proposed fees and charges to be made by West Midlands Police in 2016/17. The Commissioner is required to approve these charges through a decision before they are introduced from 1 April 2016.

INTRODUCTION AND BACKGROUND

2. West Midlands Police levies a charge to users for certain services. The rates are reviewed and approved on an annual basis. The attached document details the proposed fees and charges for 2016/17.

FINANCIAL IMPLICATIONS

- 3. The proposed rates have been calculated in line with national guidance published by National Police Chiefs' Council and have been set based on a full cost recovery. This includes the impact of a 1% pay award from September 2016. This is appropriate because most rates cover services provided by staff.
- 4. The proposed rates for Fees and Charges in 2016/17 detailed in the attached document have been calculated using national guidance and the charges have been set based on full cost recovery.

LEGAL IMPLICATIONS

5. Fees and Chargeable Rates are governed by Sections 18, 24, 25 and 26 of the Police Act 1996.
