## Freedom of Information request

An e-mail from you dated 19 September 2017 was received in this office on 17 October 2017. The purpose of that correspondence was to request information using Freedom of Information Act 2000 legislation.

You specifically asked:

- “1. How many subject access requests did you receive the identifying paperwork for and process in 2014?*
- 2. How many subject access requests did you receive the identifying paperwork for and process in 2015?*
- 3. How many subject access requests did you receive the identifying paperwork for and process in 2016?*
- 4. How many subject access requests you rejected in 2014?*
- 5. How many subject access requests you rejected in 2015?*
- 6. How many subject access requests you rejected in 2016?*
- 7. What was the average cost for you to process a subject access request in 2014?*
- 8. What was the average cost for you to process a subject access request in 2015?*
- 9. What was the average cost for you to process a subject access request in 2016?*
- 10. How much do you charge an individual to process a subject access request?”*

In response to your enquiry, I am able to confirm there is no record of any Subject Access Requests having been received in this office during the period concerned. If such a request were to be received, and in relation to your question 10, I can confirm that there would be no charge made.

The Commissioner complies with the Data Protection Principles set out in the Data Protection Act, and is committed to retain data for only as long as is necessary, and to respond properly to any request for personal data made under the Act. The Office of the Police and Crime Commissioner is registered with the Information Commissioner's Office as a data controller. The registration number is ZA002898.
