RE: Business Crime Victim Support Service

I am writing to inform you that after careful consideration, I have decided to retender the Business Crime Support Service. In my letter dated 30 April 2015, I informed you that I would review the position of the project in June/July with a view to determining if we should wait for the outcome of the ballot.

I have taken the decision to retender, as in the original process the project had a start date at the beginning of April. At this point, the project should have been delivered for 3 months and going through the first monitoring meeting to evaluate progress. I am disappointed that the project has yet to start. I have a statutory duty to deliver services to victims of crime and as a result of the delay, victims of business crime are not getting the support that they need and are entitled to.

On reflection, I will be opening this pilot project up to a wider selection of organisations, so that any organisation working with victims of crime will be eligible to apply. You will of course, be able to resubmit your application.
