# NON - CONFIDENTIAL FACTS AND ADVICE TO THE POLICE AND CRIME COMMISSIONER

#### INTRODUCTION AND BACKGROUND

Police and Crime Commissioners must appoint a person to be the head of the Commissioner's staff, referred to in the Police Reform and Social Responsibility Act as a Chief Executive (*Police Reform and Social Responsibility Act 2011*, Schedule 1). The Chief Executive is also the monitoring officer (*Police Reform and Social Responsibility Act 2011*, Schedule 16)

The current Chief Executive is leaving the Office of the Police and Crime Commissioner.

In accordance with the <u>Temporary Promotions and Honorarium Policy</u>, the Commissioner has decided to appoint a Joint Acting Chief Executive for the period until a permanent appointment is made.

The Commissioner is appointing two current members of staff from the Office of the Police and Crime Commissioner West Midlands (Alethea Fuller and Jonathan Jardine) on an equal job share basis from 20 April 2015. They will fulfil their duties on an alternating weekly basis until such time as a permanent appointment is made.

Alethea Fuller and Jonathan Jardine have both worked in the Office of the Police and Crime Commissioner and West Midlands Police Authority and have considerable experience of the policing governance function. Both have previously represented the Office of the Police and Crime Commissioner and the Chief Executive.

#### FINANCIAL IMPLICATIONS

The salary for the Joint Acting Chief Executive is set at £80,928.

Alethea Fuller and Jonathan Jardine will share equally the increment between their current salaries and that of the Joint Acting Chief Executive post.

#### **LEGAL IMPLICATIONS**

Police and Crime Commissioners must appoint a Chief Executive.

Permanent senior appointments are subject to the procedures for the scrutiny of senior appointments in Schedule 1 of the *Police Reform and Social Responsibility Act 2011.* 

Information relating the Chief Executive and senior posts must be published in accordance with the Elected Local Policing Bodies (Specified Information) Order 2011 (as amended).
