**Title: Technology Task Force: Award of IIP Contract**

**EXECUTIVE SUMMARY**

This report outlines the decision to be taken by the Acting Police and Crime Commissioner to award a contract to Accenture (UK) following the elapse of the ten day mandatory standstill period required by procurement law following decision WMPCC 020/2014.

Following the decision to make Accenture (UK) the preferred bidder to become the Innovation and Integration Partner for West Midlands Police and Crime Commissioner and West Midlands Police there have been no issues raised during the Alcatel period. Therefore a decision can be taken to award the contract.

**DECISION**

I am not aware of any reason why I should not award the contract to the preferred bidder, Accenture (UK). I therefore take the decision to sign the contract.

**NON – CONFIDENTIAL FACTS AND ADVICE TO THE ACTING POLICE AND CRIME COMMISSIONER**

Decision WMPCC 020/2014 provides background to the identification of a preferred bidder for the award of the contract for an innovation and integration partner.

On 14 July 2014 the West Midlands Police and Crime Panel made the decision to appoint Councillor Yvonne Mosquito the Acting Police and Crime Commissioner. The Police Reform and Social Responsibility Act 2011 sets out the powers that can be exercised by an Acting Police and Crime Commissioner. These include the awarding of contracts.
