Central Government agenda aimed at "turning around the lives" of 120, 000 most "troubled" families nationally.

Who is a "Troubled Family"?

Families who (as a whole) meet the following national criteria:


1)Involvement in crime/ASB 2)Kids not in school (poor attendance/exclusions) 3)Parents not in work (on benefits)- as confirmed by DWP

AND (in Coventry) the following local criteria:

1)Domestic Violence issues 2)Live in a "priority area"




	Household with one or more person <u>17 or under</u> who has a proven
	offence during the previous 12 months; and/or
Anti social behaviour & Crime	 Household where one or more members has an anti-social behaviou intervention in the last 12 months (ASBO, ABC, or antisocial behaviour injunction); and/or
	 Households subject to a housing-related antisocial behaviour intervention during the previous 12 months
	 Household in which a child has been subject to a permanent exclusion or three or more fixed-term exclusions during the previous three terms;
	and/or
Education	 Household in which a child is in a Pupil Referral Unit or alternative provision because they have previously been excluded or is not on a school roll;
	and/or
	 Household in which a child has 15%+ unauthorised absences during the previous three consecutive terms, or a pattern of attendance that causes the Head Teacher concern.
Worklessness	 Household in which an adult is in receipt of DWP out-of-work benefits.
