Helping people feel safe when they are out and about in Coventry



Look out for the Safe Places logo.

Our Safe Places scheme aims to increase your confidence and security in visiting Coventry city centre, so that help will be on hand if needed.

We want you to feel happy visiting Coventry city centre. We have arranged for some of the places/shops you regularly visit to be able to help if you need it. The places/shops will have a sticker on the door for you to recognise. We will give you a card, so that when you need help, they know what to do.

How it works

- 1. Always have the card with you.
- 2. If you get in trouble, get lost or just need help find a place with the safe place logo.
- 3. Show someone who works in the shop the card.
- 4. Ask them to help, you can use the card to help you.
- 5. The person will help you, and can call a personal contact or the police if needed.

Rules

- 1. Always stay in the front of the shop.
- 2. If you feel uncomfortable, leave.
- 3. Only show the card if you need help and the shop has a sticker.
- 4. Never give your card away.

Top Tips

- 1. Keep your contact card up to date.
- 2. Keep it in a safe place, like with your bus pass.
- 3. Try and remember one or two safe places. They are on our website.
- 4. If you lose the card, let someone know.
