Meeting opened by the stand in chairperson – **NR** and introductions of all persons present carried out.

Apologies – Alex Kendall (Chairperson), Dominic Tipping and Joanne (Youth Police Crime Commisioner)

NR outlined the purpose of the meeting as some persons had not attended a meeting before.

RG went over the laws and powers available to police officers with regard to stop and search and the difference between this and an encounter which does not need any grounds or any record made. He also explained what police should tell you and how a search of clothing should be made (outer clothing / strip search).

RG then went through the data for the previous three months. Discussion was had around this data which includes how many stop searches were conducted, the outcomes of each stop and ethnicity of the individual stopped. The grounds for the searches were also discussed.

A number of forms from the new and live system were then scrutinised by the panel.

AW mentioned the relevance of the ethnicity when a lot of the people may not actually reside within the Dudley Borough and travelling into the Borough and being searched. **NR** stated that this was something he would look into. **RG** reiterated that even if a person is searched, they do not have to give their name and address.

RG stated that he was hoping for a live web chat at the next meeting and that Alex was hoping to come out on patrol with police to see what happens during a stop and search and that the use of head cams is being considered so that there is no question as to the lawfulness of a search.
