Dear FOI applicant

Thank you for your return email received on 21 October 2019 regarding Freedom of Information request 2019-01385 in which you asked these follow-up questions:

Just to provide clarification and close this request, please advise where is the missing expense claim data for Q1 2016 and why it has not been published. Also, you advise that Mr Jamieson last claimed expenses for attending Roadssafe meetings on 08/10/2018 and Roadsafety Trust meetings on 18/07/2019.

I notice that he is still on the board of Roadssafe and it seems strange that he may have missed their meetings and award ceremonies / meals for the past 12 months, so please complete my FOI Q2 by advising does Mr Jamieson have, in his diary, any planned meet ups with Roadssafe before the end of this year, and has he had any meet ups with Roadssafe, as per his diary, since 08/10/2018 but not bothered to claim expenses for.

In response to your first question, I can advise you that this information is now published and available on our website. I would like to thank you for making us aware of this issue, and offer an explanation that the data was not published due to an oversight likely caused during our website transition earlier this year.

To answer your second question, I can inform you that David was invited on 26 March 2019 to a roadsafe meeting but didn't attend as he was out of the office. He did attend a meeting held on 08 October 2019. He has not attended any other meeting that may have been held between these dates. There are also no further roadsafe meetings in the PCC's diary for the remainder of this year.

Freedom of Information Right of Appeal

Any person who has requested information from West Midlands Office of the Police and Crime Commissioner and is unhappy with the way their request for information has been handled can request a review of their case.

A request for review must be made in writing by letter or email to the Legal Advisor to the Police and Crime Commissioner. You should include the reference number of your request if you have it, and outline why you are requesting the review to:

All requests for review will be recorded. Receipt of a request for internal review will be acknowledged and the appellant informed of an estimated date for determining the outcome. West Midlands Officer of the Police and Crime Commissioner will attempt to respond to internal reviews as soon as practicable and in any case within two months.

All investigations will be undertaken by the Legal Advisor.

The result of any internal review will be communicated to the appellant outlining the decisions taken. If you remain dissatisfied with the handling of your request or complaint, you have a right to appeal to the Information Commissioner at:
