
DECISION

NON - CONFIDENTIAL FACTS AND ADVICE TO THE POLICE AND CRIME COMMISSIONER

INTRODUCTION AND BACKGROUND

1. The Force is able to levy a charge to users for certain services. The charges for 2020/21 are shown in the attached Fees and Chargeable Rates schedule. The rates are reviewed, refreshed and approved annually. The Commissioner authorised the original schedule for fees and charges in decision number 014 – 2020. However, the Force has now informed the OPCC that there is a need to include a charge for Body Worn Video footage. This is detailed in Section 4 of the attached schedule.

FINANCIAL IMPLICATIONS

2. Rates have been calculated using the fees and charges methodology and have included the expected pay award from 1st September 2020 for police officers. This is appropriate as most of the rates cover services provided by staff.

LEGAL IMPLICATIONS

3. Fees and Chargeable Rates are governed by Sections 18, 24, 25 and 26 of the Police Act 1996.

EQUALITY IMPLICATIONS

4. The fees and chargeable rates are based on either statutory amounts or have been calculated using the agreed national framework and are applied consistently irrespective of colour, race, religion, gender or sexual orientation.
