- 3. If not, what action is West Midlands now intending to take, to address the alleged content/social media activity/views referred to in the article?
- 4. Apart from Dr Mustafa's role as Course Director at Staffordshire University in relation to police training, have West Midlands Police worked with Dr Mustafa in any other capacity?
- 5. What reassurance is West Midlands Police able to provide to me about the action that has been taken, in order to manage any risks that exist in relation to Dr Mustafa in his capacity as Course Director at Staffordshire University in relation to police training, in any other capacity in which he has worked with West Midlands Police or at all.

"The founding chair of NAMP's West Midlands branch has shared conspiracy theories about the origins of al-Qa'ida and Islamic State, and promoted content which called for the destruction of

Israel and described Jews as "filth". He also shared a video of a talk given by a cleric who has previously praised Hamas and a post from ex-Guantanamo Bay detainee Moazzam Begg, now of CAGE. Begg's post criticised Muslim leaders who develop community outreach projects, claiming that, by doing so, they are "adopt[ing] the language of the oppressors". I was disturbed to learn that this individual has worked with government departments on counter-terrorism and security policy. In 2020, he authored a paper for NAMP advising Counter Terrorism Policing to drop the terms 'Islamism' and 'Jihadism', which was later discussed at a meeting attended by senior policing figures." pp123-124

A spokesman for the West Midlands Police and Crime Commissioner, said: "Police and Crime Commissioners are expressly precluded from interfering with operational policing.

"That is why when the comments in the Independent Review of Prevent, relating to Dr Rizwan Mustafa, were raised with the Commissioner he referred the matter to West Midlands Police.

"West Midlands Police have concluded that neither the material referenced in the Independent Review of Prevent, nor the manner in which it was shared, contravenes Section 58 of the Terrorism Act 2000 or the Public Order Act 1986.

"As a consequence West Midlands Police have determined that they will not be taking further action."


