

Dear FOI Applicant,

Thank you for your freedom of information request received in this office on **26 February** 2024 in which you asked:

'Can you kindly provide me with a copy of your most recent Executive Summary/Evaluation of your Perpetrator Programme(s) funded fully or in part by the Home Office Perpetrator Fund.'

In response to your request, I can confirm that the most recent fund is the 2023-25 fund, which includes our EASI and Pathways 2 Change (P2C) programmes.

The interim evaluation for EASI is available online here: <u>Early Awareness Stalking Intervention</u> (EASI) Evaluation Report : University of Derby Repository - Further evaluation of this intervention is currently being undertaken and is expected to be published in or around April 2025.

P2C commenced on 2<sup>nd</sup> October 2023. The evaluation is being conducted by Cardiff Met and is expected to be published following the commencement of the intervention in or around April 2025.

## Freedom of Information Right of Appeal

Any person who has requested information from the Office of the Police and Crime Commissioner (OPCC) and is unhappy with the way their request for information has been handled can request a review of their case.

A request for review must be made in writing by letter or email. You should include the reference number of your request if you have it, and outline why you are requesting the review to:

All requests for review will be recorded. Receipt of a request for internal review will be acknowledged and the appellant informed of an estimated date for determining the outcome. The OPCC will attempt to respond to internal reviews as soon as practicable and in any case within two months.

All investigations will be undertaken by someone not involved in the original response.

The result of any internal review will be communicated to the appellant outlining the decisions taken.

If you remain dissatisfied with the handling of your request or complaint, you have a right to appeal to the Information Commissioner at:
