For one off filming: Interviews with Police Officers and Police Staff

West Midlands Police charges documentary and film makers for the whole time that an officer or member of staff is required as part of any recording, including being interviewed or supporting recording.

These charges reflect the fact that during the recording process, the officer or member of the staff is unavailable for operational policing duty.

Charges are dependent on the officer or staff member's rank, to recover the cost to West Midlands Police. Please see charges in the table below.

Please note, any time supported by a member of the force's Corporate Communications department during filming will not be charged.

Using Police sites as a location for one-off filming

This schedule provides a framework of the applicable fees and charges. Specific access and fees will need to be agreed on a case by case basis with the Assistant Director - Corporate Communications taking into account the requirements of individual projects.

Expenses incurred by Police Officers and Police Staff

West Midlands Police charges documentary and film makers for expenses incurred by an officer or staff member during filming. This may include, but is not limited to: parking charges, mileage costs, food and drink. We also charge for expenses incurred by the force's Corporate Communications department if they are supporting recording.
