3.	Dip sample record Strip Search -	WMP: Improved narrative needed from officers with more detail. In almost all records seen by both groups more text was needed to demonstrate justification of powers. The legislation to use the power isn't a justification of why officers' choice to use the power.
	Dip sample of Use of Force records	Use of Force forms requested to be combined with EDL as not always listed on records. Improved narrative needed from officers with more detail.
